I apologize, as I thought that I had done a good job communicating this with families via an all-call and an email before school started on August 18th, creating videos outlining the policies and having them posted online on our website and sharing on our Facebook page the slideshow presentation that was used in the videos that students viewed on the 1st day of school. There seems to still be some confusion, so I want to make sure that everyone is on the same page.

For review, slides 15 & 16 in the video/slideshow contain the information that everyone should be following.

Shorts, skirts and dresses should be mid-thigh. To find the mid-thigh point, locate the bottom of the bottom and the top of the knee. The middle of this area should be mid-thigh. This takes into consideration long arms and legs. (I am 5'10" and I get it.) This will apply to anyone wearing shorts.

This is a new school year and all students will be required to follow the rules, guidelines, policies, and procedures that are in place.
