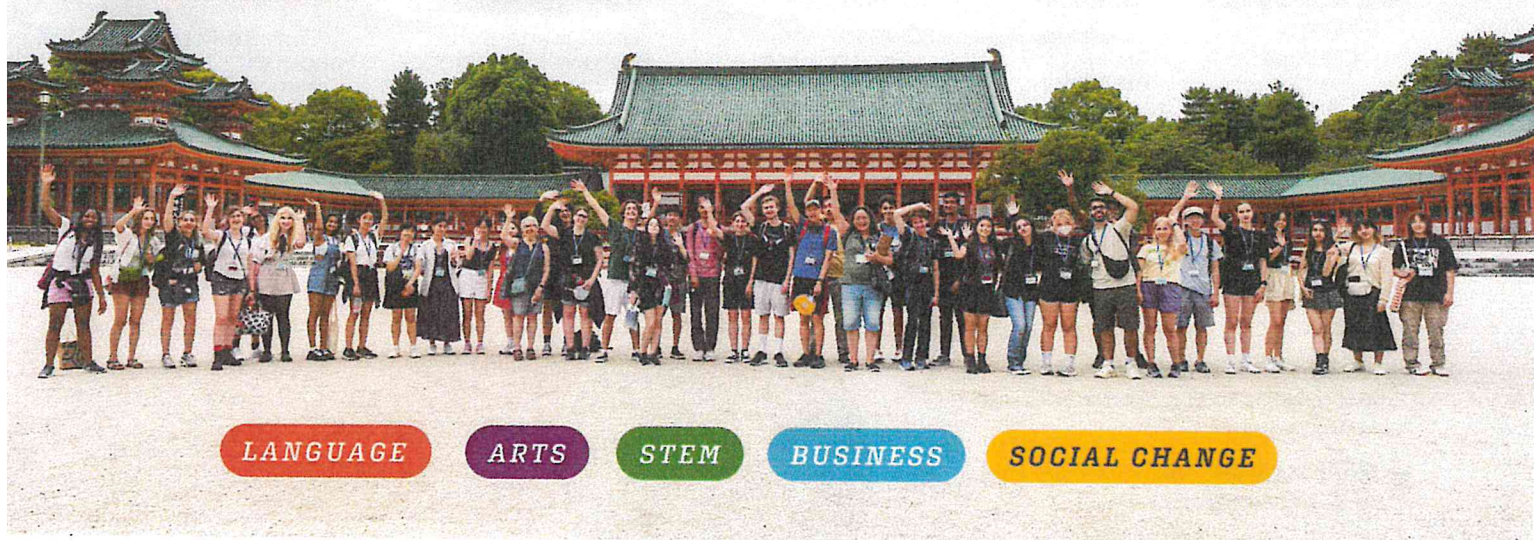

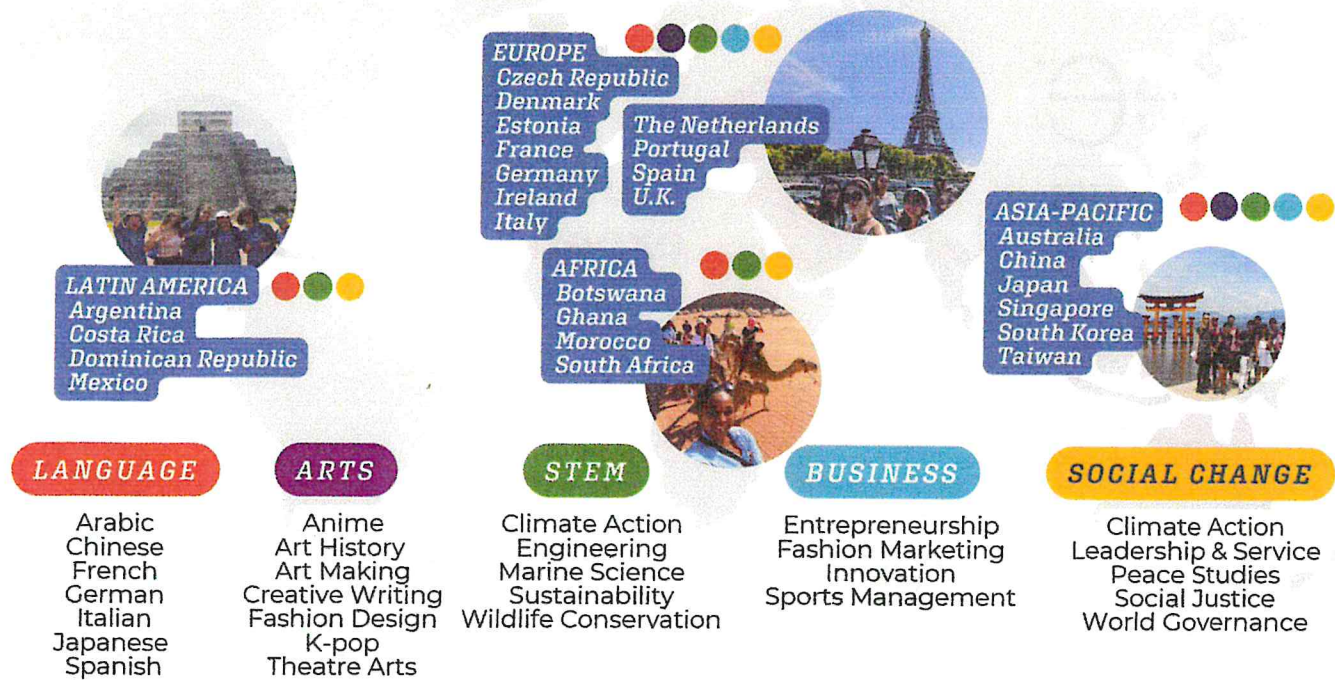

- **Dates:**
 - Language programs last 4 weeks.
 - All other programs last 3 weeks.
 - Session 1 starts June 2**, 9 or 16.
 - Session 2 starts June 30** or July 7.
- **Eligibility:**
 - Complete grade 9 - graduating seniors.
- **Housing:**
 - Host families on language programs and select program locations.
 - Shared accommodations on other programs.
- **Tuition**
 - Starts at \$4,750 and includes housing, all meals, classes, activities, ground transportation abroad, and student travel insurance.
 - Tuition does not include airfare, passport or visa costs.
 - Scholarships can cover up to 100% of tuition costs.

HOST AN EXCHANGE STUDENT WITH CIEE

Hosting an exchange student gives you the opportunity to learn new customs and perspectives, allows you to share American culture, and build connections that cross borders and often last a lifetime.

Hosts come in all shapes and sizes; you can live in a rural farming community or an urban high rise; you can have children or not; you can be actively working or retired and looking to infuse your life with the energy of a teenager. Hosts are volunteers and receive no compensation. If you have an interest in sharing your culture and learning something new, you can be a host!

WHY SHOULD YOU HOST?

1. Experience another culture firsthand.
2. Have fun! Learn new recipes, celebrate new holidays, and so much more.
3. Add an international member to your family.
4. Start learning a new language
5. Catch the travel bug! After bringing the world into your home, you may be inspired to get out and explore it yourself.
6. Share your own culture. This is a reciprocal experience!
7. Create memories that span the globe and last a lifetime.

CAN YOU BE A HOST FAMILY?

Hosts must be 25 years old or older and must be able to provide:

- A welcoming home for one or two high school semesters
- Family support
- A bedroom and a bed (students can share rooms with children of the same gender within four years of his/her age)
- An appropriate place to study
- Meals at home and school
- Assistance coordinating appropriate transportation

Hosting a student with CIEE is a life-changing, educational experience. When you become a CIEE host family, you are supported by our 70+ years of experience in international exchange. We are in your community and around the world, here for you no matter what.

WHY HOST WITH CIEE?

CIEE students are open and eager to join your family and participate in day to day activities. Our students:

- Come from over 70 countries
- Are ages 15-18
- Have 3 or more years of English language study
- Receive medical insurance through CIEE

Work with a Local Coordinator (LC) who lives nearby and is ready to support you

Your LC will be there to provide supervision and support throughout your experience. Local Coordinators will:

- Match your family to an international student based on personality traits, hobbies, and more.
- Conduct a host family orientation
- Introduce you to your international student
- Complete monthly supervision reports
- Be available to you or your international student to offer support whenever needed.

Access 24/7 multilingual phone support from CIEE's dedicated support services

CIEE's highly trained and multilingual support staff is available 24/7 by phone in case of emergencies. Our support team will:

- Help resolve conflicts should any arise
- Assist with cultural adjustment issue
- Provide support in the event of an emergency
